## **ADMISSION TO BSC NURSING COURSE under N.R.I. CATEGORY SEATS Academic Year 2018-19 – Information Brochure & Instructions to the Applicants**

**Applications for admission to first year BSC Nursing course (Academic year 2018-19) in the Ten (10) NRI category seats at this college are being invited.**

### **1. GENERAL INFORMATION**

M.O.S.C. College of Nursing is attached to M.O.S.C. Medical College Hospital which is a 1100 bedded multi specialty hospital. The institution has excellent infrastructural facilities for both academic and extracurricular activities. The college also has excellent infrastructure setup with clinical facilities available in the same campus. Students have been performing well in the University examinations. The college aims at the total development of the students .

#### **University Affiliation**

The College is affiliated to Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur.

#### **Prohibition of Ragging**

Ragging/any type of misconduct towards any student both in the college campus or outside will be considered as criminal offence and will be immediately reported to the police. Perpetrators will not be permitted to continue their studies. Every student shall, at the time of admission, furnish a character certificate from the institute wherefrom he/she has passed the qualifying Examination, which would mention the status of his/her behavioral pattern especially in terms as to whether he/she has displayed persistent violent, or aggressive behavior or any desire to harm others.

Students and parents shall, at the time of admission, furnish an affidavit to the effect that the students will not indulge in any form of ragging.

The use of cell phones are banned in the college.

Every student is required to adhere strictly to the code of conduct of the institution.

## 2. SEAT DISTRIBUTION

All the seats under NRI quota are open to all categories of applicants.

## 3. Eligibility:

To be eligible to apply for the Bsc nursing course under the NRI category:-

- i. the applicant must have completed and passed the Higher Secondary Examination of the Board of Higher Secondary Education-Kerala OR an examination recognized equivalent thereto with at least 60% marks in Biology, Physics and Chemistry put together, after a period of 12 years of study. The aggregate marks obtained in the qualifying examination should be at least 50%.
  - Rounding off of the percentage of marks to the nearest whole number is not permitted.
  - Candidates who have not passed their qualifying exam from the Kerala Higher Secondary Board, the CBSE or the ICSE, shall provide an equivalency certificate obtained from the KUHS (Kerala University for Health Sciences)
- ii. Applicants must be at least 17 years of age on 31<sup>st</sup> December 2018 (the date of birth being shown on the Matriculation or equivalent certificate).
- iii. The norms of eligibility prescribed by the Indian Nursing Council / Kerala Nurses & Midwives Council / Kerala University of Health Sciences shall also apply.
- iv. According to GO(MS) No.243/2014/H&FWD dated 06.08.2014, "*An Applicant who depends upon his/her Father / Mother / Brothers and Sisters (inclusive of first cousins) / Husband / Wife / Brothers and Sisters (inclusive of first cousins) of Father or Mother / Half Brother / Half Sister / Adopted Father or Adopted Mother who is working abroad*" will only be eligible to apply in the NRI category seats.
- v. **The following documents in original to prove the NRI status of the sponsor and his/her relationship with the applicant shall be submitted at the time of admission. In no case an applicant is allowed to submit these documents at a later date and that non submission of the documents at the time of admission will result in cancellation of the allotment.**
  - a. Employment certificate of the sponsor duly attested by the concerned embassy **OR** If self-employed, a statement to that effect duly attested by the concerned embassy.
  - b. Copy of the relevant pages of the passport of the sponsor containing currently valid visa details duly attested by the concerned embassy.
  - c. An affidavit/declaration (*find specimen format Annexure-1*) by the NRI sponsor.
  - d. Certificate to prove the relationship between the candidate & sponsor. The certificates establishing the relationship between the candidate and the sponsor shall be obtained only from the concerned Thasildar/ Village Officer, with the required details and corroborating documents, and mere statements by the Thasildar/ Village Officer stating the relationship shall not be accepted. However the relationships between the candidate and the father/mother, which are recorded in the educational register, maintained in the usual course of transactions by the competent authorities, shall be accepted when included in the certificate.

- e. The candidate has to prove that he/she is the dependent of the sponsor.
- f. Certificate issued by a Scheduled Bank stating that the sponsor is a Non-Resident Indian holding an NRE account.

**4. TUITION FEES:** The Annual Tuition Fees for the course is Rs.95000/ (Rs. Ninety five thousand only)The tuition fees should be remitted as demand draft in favor of the MOSC Medical Mission Hospital payable at Kolenchery out of the fund maintained by the sponsor in an NRE account.

Special fees: In addition to the annual tuition fees a special fees of Rs.17000/ (Rs. Seventeen thousand only) should be paid each year along with the tuition fees.

Apart from above, the students will be required to pay Caution deposit, the proportionate administration / affiliation / examination fee payable to the university from time to time, PTA/ Union fund etc.. Hostel & Mess fee will be charged separately.

#### **5. HOW TO APPLY:**

- i. Application form can be downloaded from the college website
- ii. Duly filled application form along with self attested copies of the required documents and DD for Rs.1000/- (Rupees one Thousand only) in favor of MOSC Medical Mission Hospital payable at Kolenchery shall be submitted to the College.
- iii. The filled in applications should reach THE PRINCIPAL, MOSC College of Nursing, Kolenchery, Ernakulam- 682311 on or before 3:00 p.m., on 15th June, 2018. The applicants, at their own interest, are advised to submit the application in person and obtain acknowledgement from the college office. For applications send through post courier or other means the college cannot be held responsible for non-receipt or late receipt of applications, under any circumstances.
- iv. The application form should be completed carefully; furnishing the entire information called for. Late and incomplete applications, and applications not in the prescribed format will be summarily rejected.
- vi. Self-attested Photocopies of the following documents shall be attached with the Application (The originals documents will have to be submitted at the time of admission).
  - a) Proof of date of birth .
  - b) School Leaving Certificate (S.S.L.C.)
  - c) Plus Two/12<sup>th</sup> standard certificate
  - d) Mark list of qualifying examination (Plus Two/12<sup>th</sup> Std.)
  - e) A statement to show that the high school in which the student has studied has been accredited by the State/Country/University (if applicable).
  - f) Equivalence Certificate from Association of Indian Universities (if applicable).
  - g) Eligibility certificate from Kerala University of Health Sciences (if applicable).
  - h) Copies of all documents as prescribed in clause 3(v)

Candidates are instructed **NOT TO ENCLOSE ANY ORIGINAL CERTIFICATES** along with the application.

## **6. SELECTION AND ADMISSION**

The open merit and category wise rank lists of all applicants will be prepared and published on the website [www.moscomm.org](http://www.moscomm.org) on the basis of the total percentage of marks obtained in the core subjects of the qualifying examination

The open merit rank will be prepared on the basis of the percentage of marks obtained in Physics, Chemistry and Biology or equivalent subjects in the qualifying examination. The marks obtained for the qualifying exam will be subject to normalisation process as explained below.

This process will be done taking into consideration the marks of those candidates who apply pursuant to this prospectus only.

The marks obtained by the students in the relevant subjects in the qualifying examination conducted by various boards or authority shall be equated with the marks obtained by the students in the same subjects in the qualifying Examination conducted by the Director of HSE, Kerala, by adopting the method of normalisation.

Allotment will be notified online only and no personal intimation will be issued

An applicant who receives an online allotment will have to join the college within the notified date and time schedule by submitting the original documents and remitting the fees payable to the College. Hostel fees, special fees etc. shall be paid by the students at the time of admission. While reporting for admission, all the relevant certificates/documents in original should be submitted to the Principal of the institution. If the applicant is not joining the college as above within the specified date, the allotment shall stand cancelled and all his/her rights in the admission process shall be forfeited.

For genuine reasons, management of the individual Colleges will have the right to deny admission to any candidate, even if otherwise eligible. Reasons for such denial will be recorded and intimated to the candidates concerned, if requested for.

If during the scrutiny or any time thereafter any discrepancy or tampering of facts is noticed, the admission is liable to be cancelled. The candidate shall be expelled and criminal action shall be initiated against them.

## **7. DISCONTINUATION AFTER THE CLOSURE OF ADMISSION**

Any student admitted as per this prospectus who discontinues his/her studies under NRI quota in this college after the closure of admissions shall be liable to pay liquidated damages to the college equal to the entire tuition fees of the course. In such cases, Transfer Certificate and other certificates will be issued only after the payment of the damages or on execution of a bond by the student along with his/her Parents, undertaking to pay the amount that may be ordered by the ASC/FRC or the Court of Law.

## **8. OTHERS**

All students who get selected should get themselves vaccinated against Hepatitis before admission. A certificate to the effect shall be produced at the time of admission or before commencement of the course.
