PHILOSOPHY

The faculty of this College of Nursing believe that nursing is a profession which is based on a continuously evolving body of knowledge. Nursing is a service to humanity, which works in collaboration with other health professionals in helping individuals, families and society to maintain and promote health to care during illness and to rehabilitate to the maximum possible level.
