PHILOSOPHY

The faculty of this College of Nursing believes that nursing is a profession that is based on a continuously evolving body of knowledge. Nursing is a service to humanity, which works in collaboration with other health professionals in helping individuals, families, and society to maintain and promote health, to care during illness, and to rehabilitate to the maximum possible level. Nursing is a service that has a holistic concept considering the uniqueness of the human being, which is an integration of physical, mental, social, intellectual, and spiritual domains.

We believe that health is a dynamic state as the person adapts to changes in the internal and external environment, to maintain a state of physical, emotional, social, intellectual, and spiritual wellbeing. We believe that a degree program in nursing shall be designed to enable young men and women with essential basic knowledge, skills, and attitude to render professional nursing service at first-level positions in hospitals and the community. The graduates with experience can rapidly move into leadership positions in Nursing Education, Nursing Service, Nursing Administration, and Nursing Research.

The B.Sc., M.Sc., and PhD Nursing programs shall include curricular and non-curricular activities which will ensure all-around personal and professional development of the student who shall become competent to hold responsible positions in the society and profession and to contribute positively to the health and welfare of the nation as a responsible citizen.

We believe that the curriculum of the B.Sc. Degree, and M.Sc. Degree courses should provide opportunities for developing cognitive, psychomotor, and affective domains of students so that they develop as persons of value and will be sensitive to the needs, hopes, sorrows, and burdens of those whom they serve. We also recognize that nursing education should equip the students with adequate knowledge and a responsible manner for the benefit of society.
